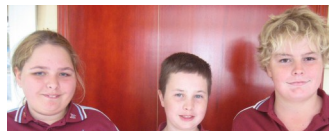
Jasmine's Pine Cone

This week Mr Sanders last week at Rocky River public school. The students will sorely miss him because we will not see him because he is moving to Coffs Harbour.

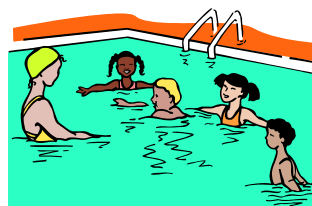
