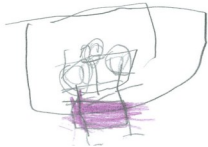

### FROM OUR STUDENT LEADERS



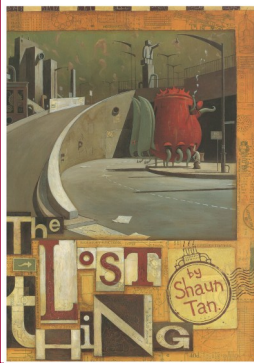
Welcome back everyone we hope that everybody had a safe and happy holiday.
