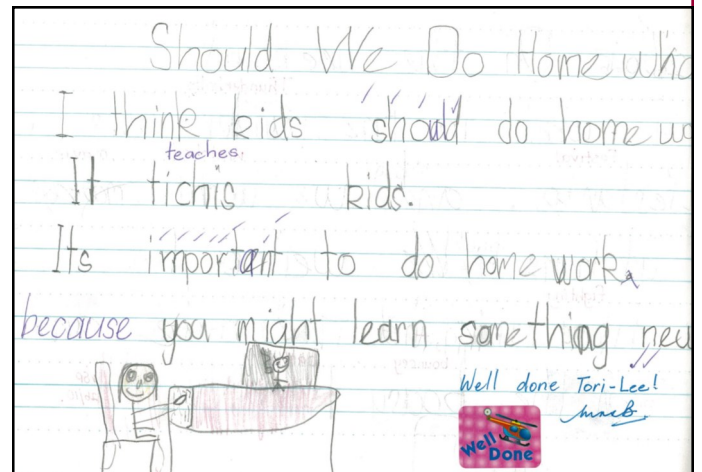
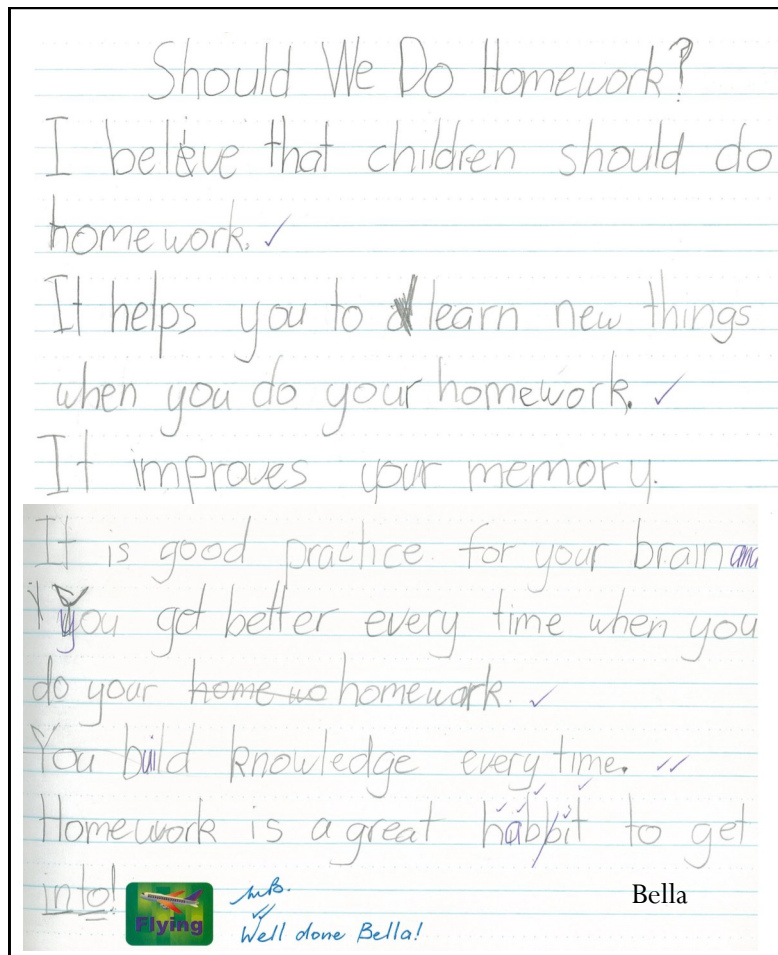
On Wednesday 25th November, the students will be taking part in a free aquatic safety program called “Bush to Beach.”

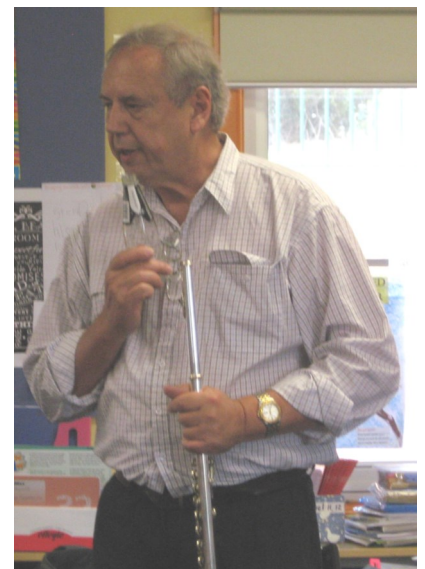

Mini Ham & Pineapple Pizza

15 minute preparation Serves 4

Ingredients

2 English muffins
¼ cup of tomato paste
100g ham
200g pineapple pieces, tinned
80-100g of grated reduced fat cheese*

Procedure

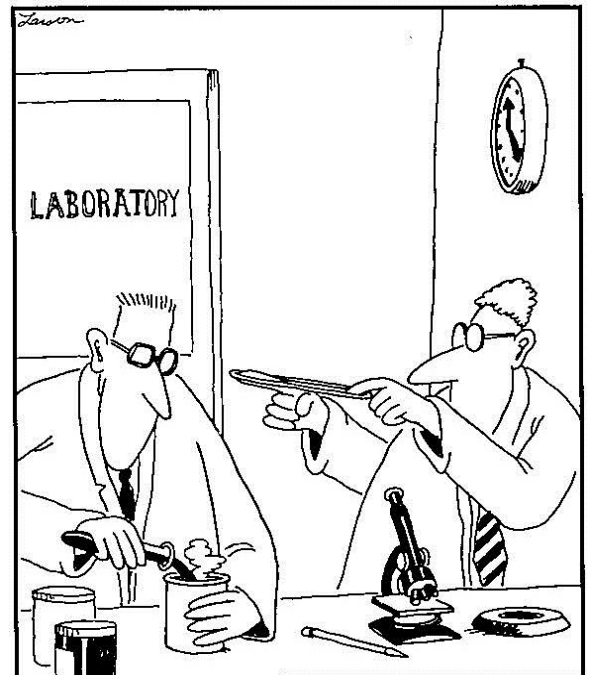
Preheat oven to 200° C.
Split muffins in half and toast.
Spread with tomato paste.
Sprinkle with ham and pineapple.
Top each muffin with grated cheese.
and place in a hot oven for 10 minutes and serve.

Variation

Extra toppings can be added, e.g. sliced onion and sliced capsicum, at the same time as the ham and pineapple.
