





We have begun some Christmas craft activities which are brightening up our classroom.

Pinky's 'Oatmeal' Muffins

1 cup flour (wholemeal, spelt, buckwheat, gluten free mix)
1 ½ tsp baking powder (or baking soda if using buttermilk or yoghurt)
1 cup rolled oats or quinoa (gluten free option)
1 cup 'milk' or yoghurt or buttermilk (rice milk/oat milk/ soy milk/ almond milk)
2 TBS raw sugar or honey
1/3 cup oil (sunflower / olive/ coconut)
1 egg (optional)

Fruit – grated or chopped pear (low salicylate); grated apple; mashed banana (Makes muffins soft and moist); berries; nectarines; carrot and cinnamon; rhubarb and apple; lemon and coconut– whatever you like.

Mix everything together, bake at 180 degrees for 10 – 15 minutes

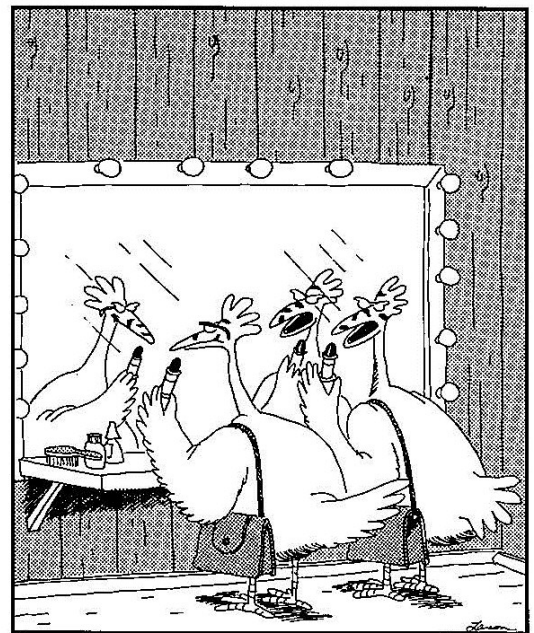
The P&C are currently asking if each family could donate some lollies for our Presentation Night festivities.
