## SAFETY DAY

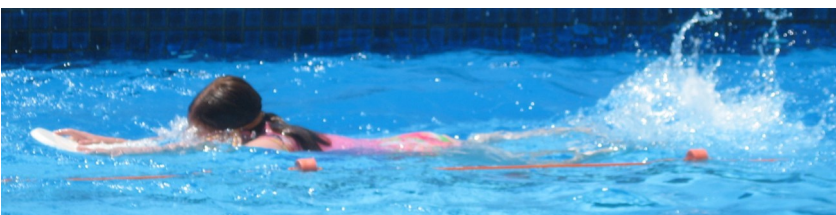
