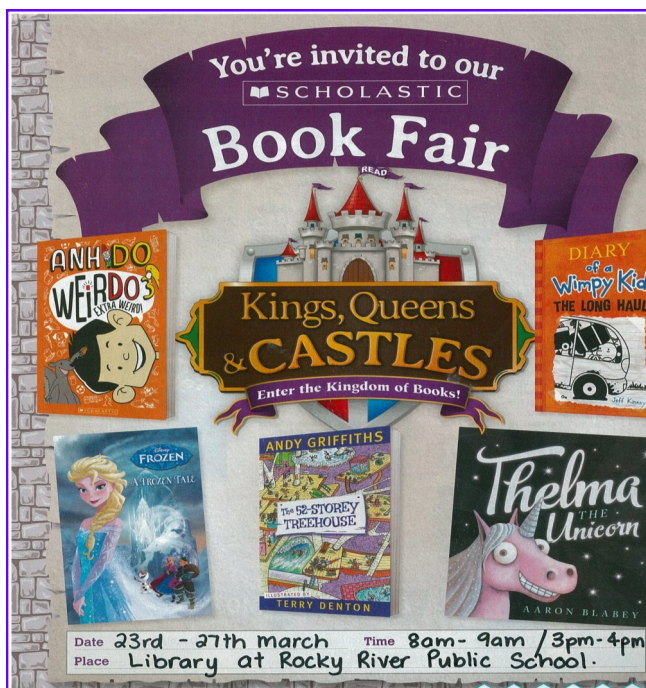

PRINCIPALS MESSAGE

Some of our students are entering their art work in the Rotary Art Exhibition which is being held in the Uralla Memorial Hall. Why not drop in and see a wide range of quality paintings from artists from across NSW. The official opening is Friday 20th March.

A number of students are arriving at school before 8:30 am. Teachers are not on duty until 8:30 and they use time prior to this for preparation of lessons. If students have a need to be at school earlier than 8:30, parents need to make arrangements with me in case there will be no-one at the school before 8:30. It is also a requirement of the Department that all students who are late arrivals are to be signed in by a parent. More rigorous record keeping of student absences is now required of all schools. All absences must be explained within 7 days. Family holidays and extra long weekends outside of school vacation periods are discouraged by the department and Principals can no longer grant a certificate of exemption for this purpose. Students who do not attend school for at least 85% of the required days will be monitored by the Home School Liaison Officer.

Non-attendance is considered a serious problem.

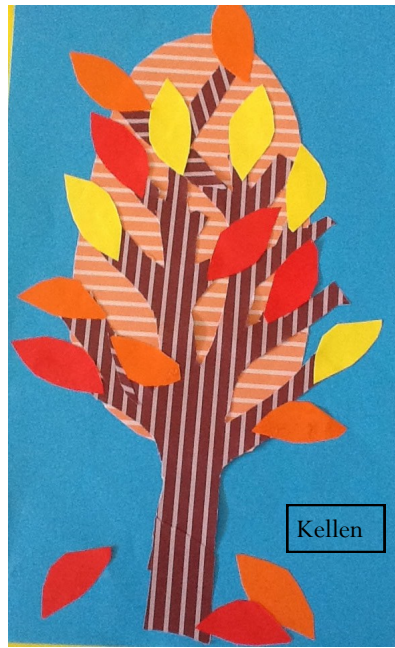


MUFTY DAY!

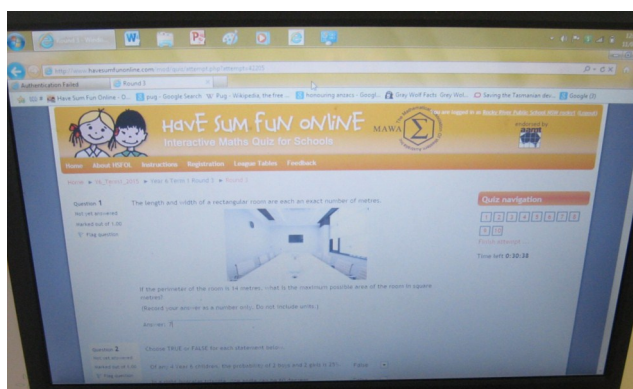

School Athletics Carnival

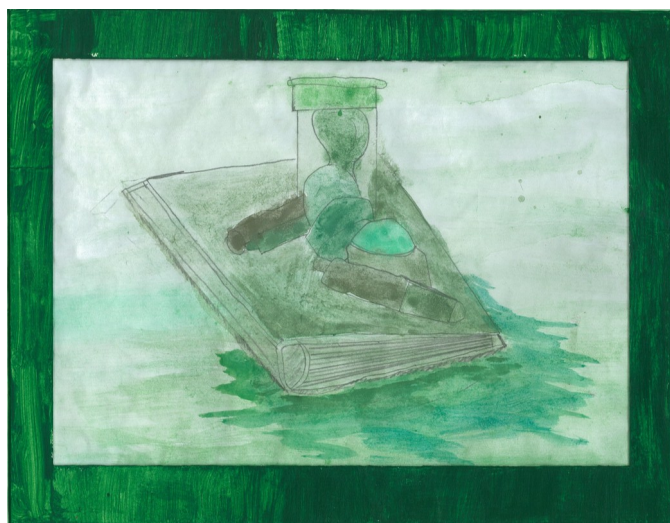
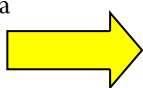

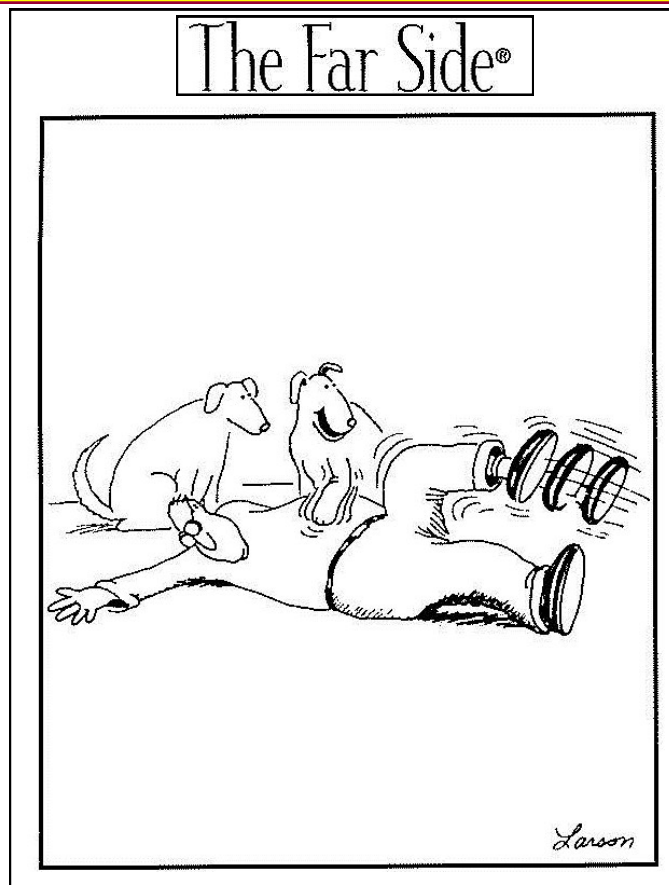
