SCHOOL JACKETS

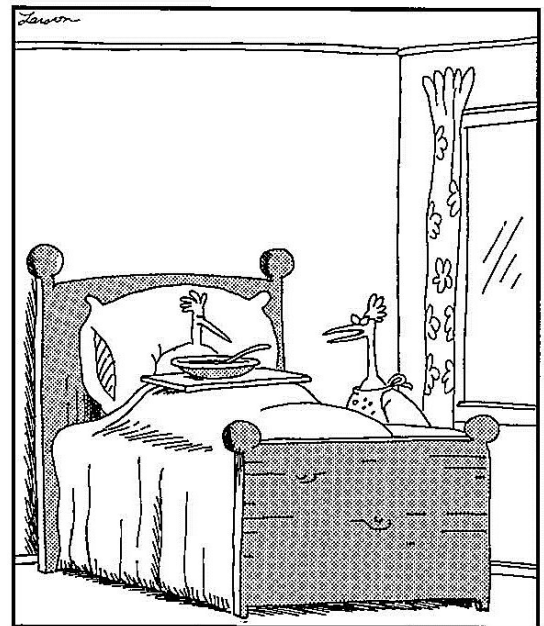
