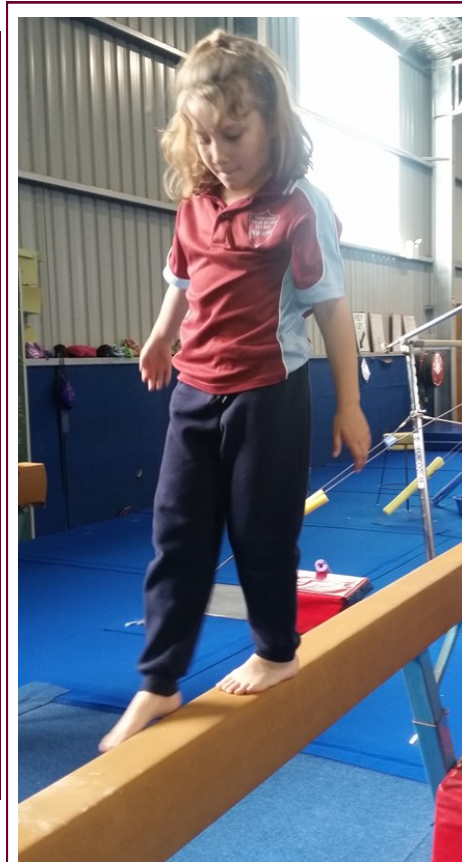

On Friday Abby Endacott and Harrison Miller travelled to Coolah for District Cross Country. Well done to both students on your achievements this year.

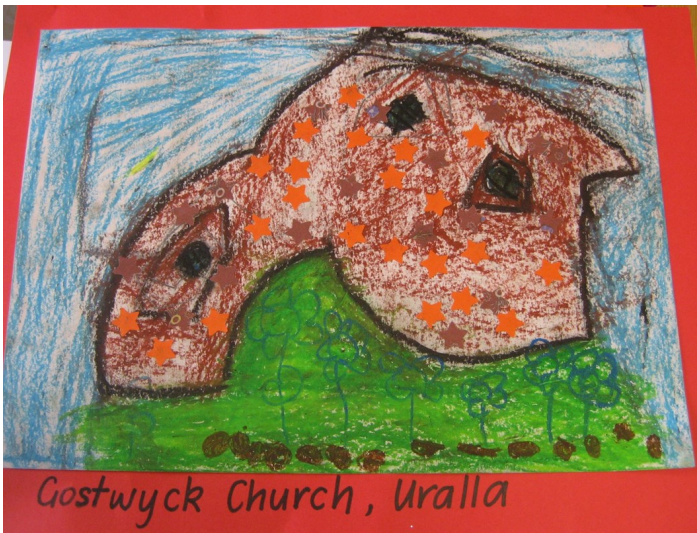
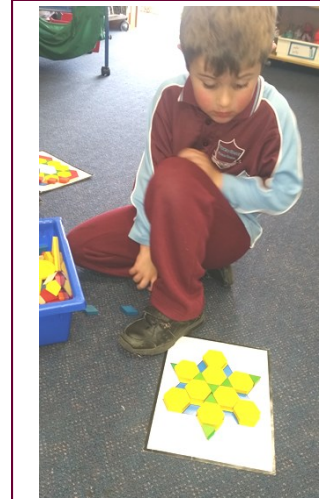


ART WORK BY LOWER DIVISION

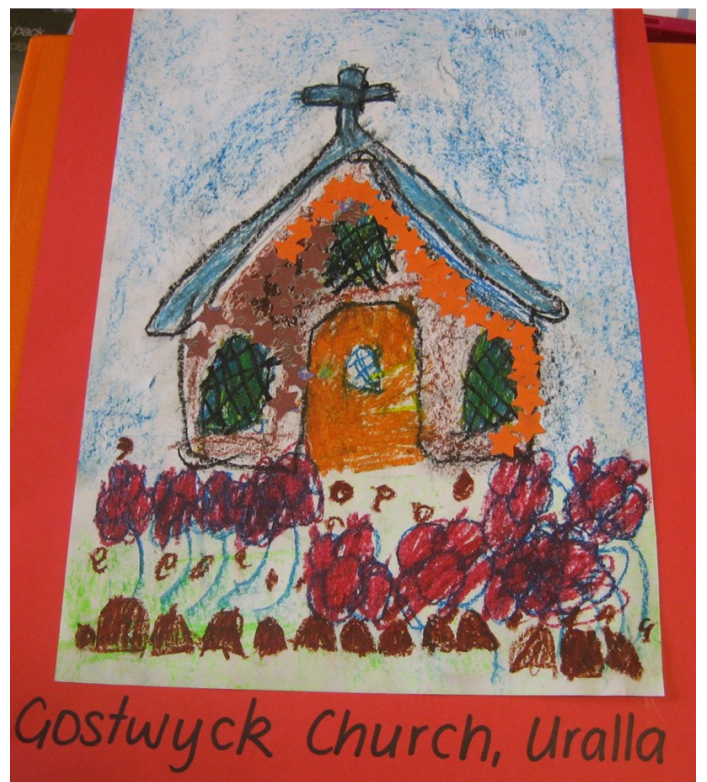

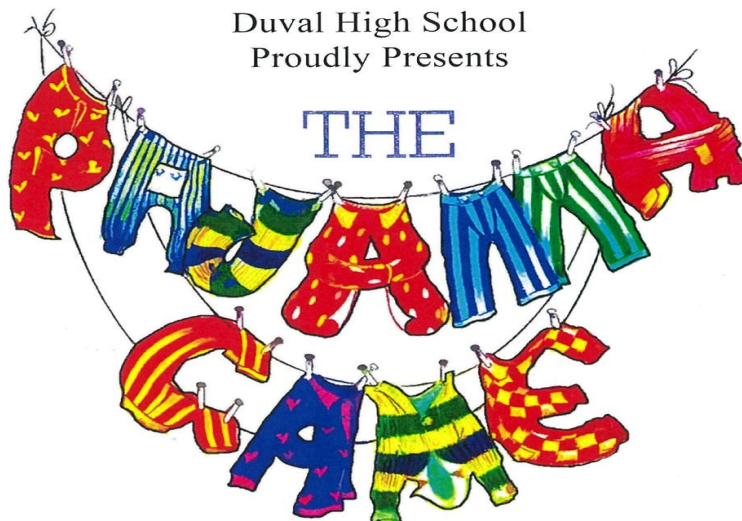

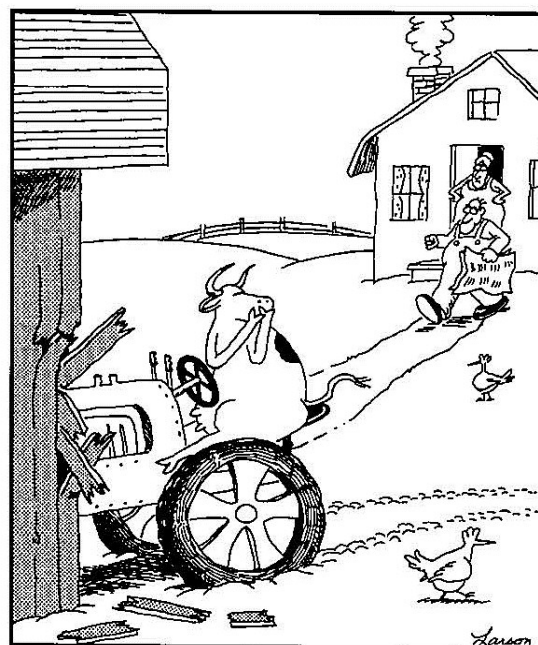
