There may be times when students are late to school. It is departmental policy that parents/carers escort the child into school and sign them in on the register. Absences are recorded for partial absences as well full days.

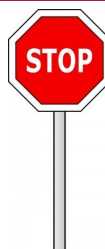
SCHOOL PHOTO'S 3 March 2017

It was Ella Peterson who came 1st in the 8 yr girls 50m freestyle and not Ella Ward.

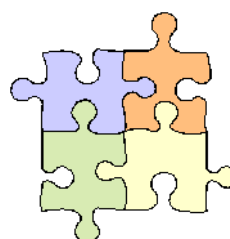


We ask that parents/caregivers please use the U-turn bay provided when dropping off and picking up students as it is illegal and dangerous to turn around in front of the school.

Uralla Preschool currently has vacancies for 4 years olds who will be enrolling at school in 2018.

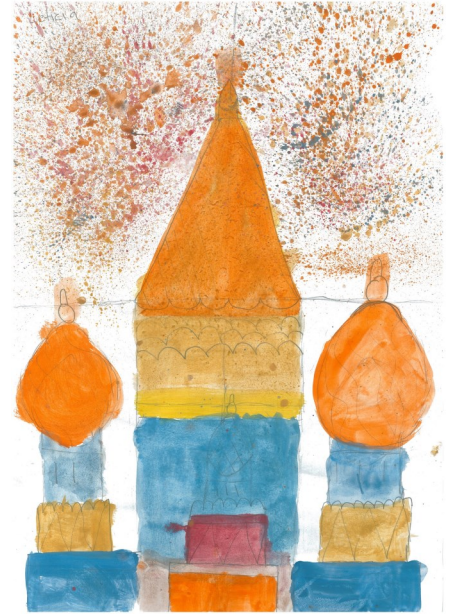

Lower Division students are learning about Fractured Fairy tales . They have been reading various fairy tale stories and doing some art works to display in their class room.



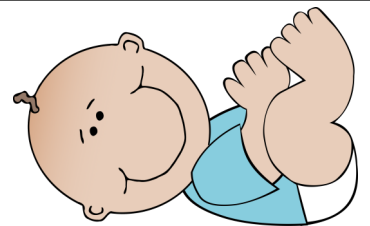
KEEPING UP WITH LOWER DIVISION
