PRINCIPALS MESSAGE

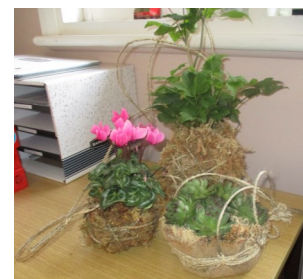
I was very proud of all our students at the Cross Country yesterday. Their manners were impeccable and they showed great determination and courage.

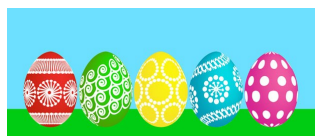
City Hockey Club

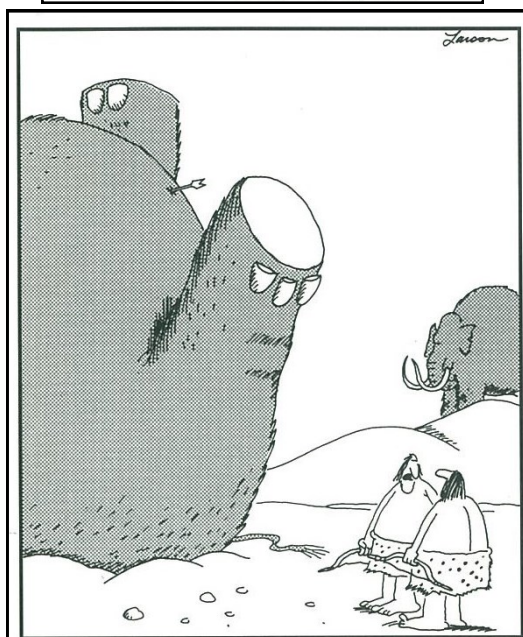
