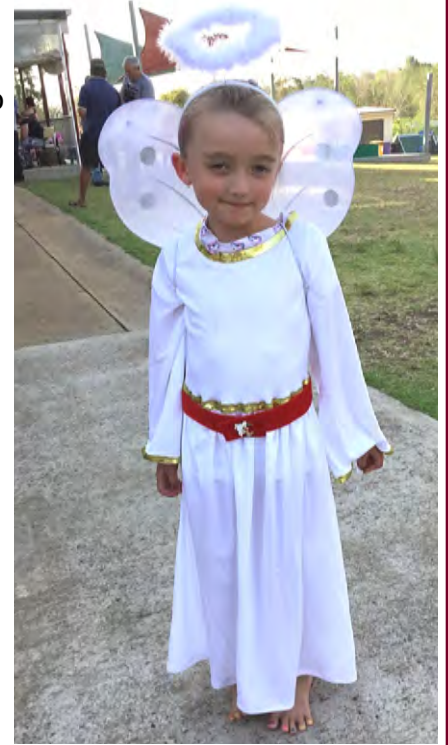

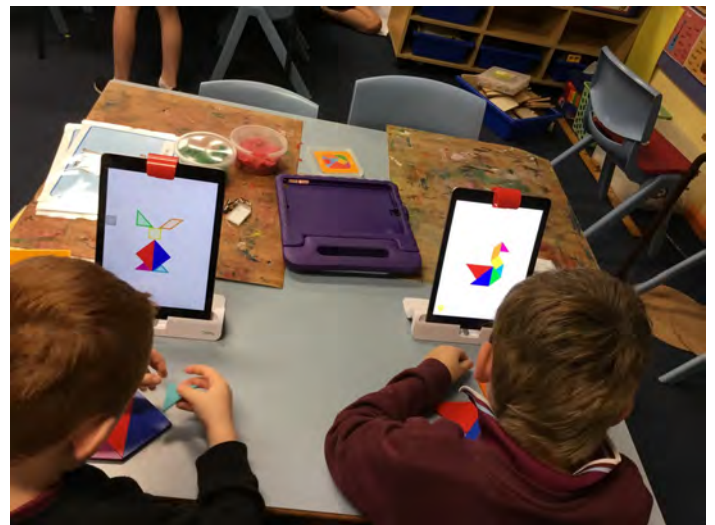


## LOOK WHAT'S HAPPENING IN OUR SCHOOL

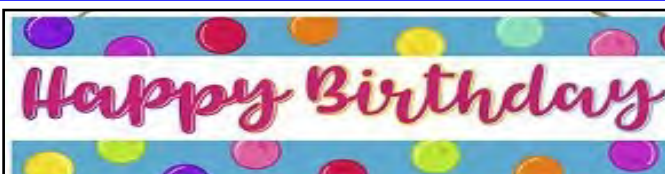
