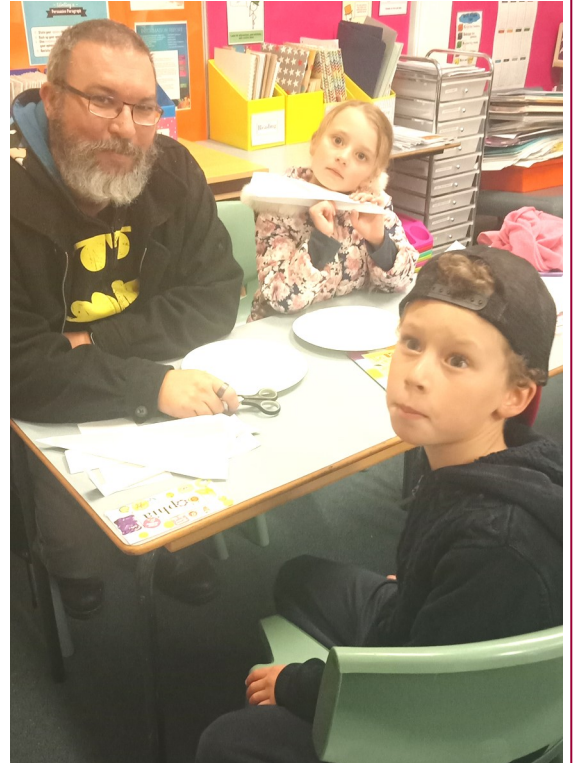
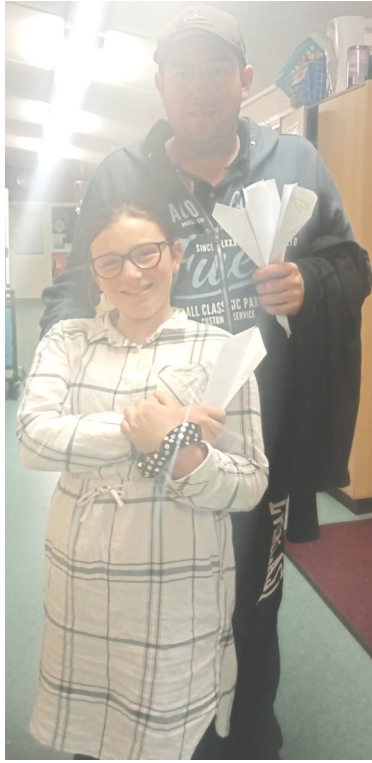
The Fathering Project
